







COLLECTOR-EMITTER SATURATION VOLTAGE CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




COLLECTOR-EMITTER SATURATION VOLTAGE CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)

CAPACITANCE CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




COLLECTOR-EMITTER VOLTAGE VCE (V)



#### HALF-BRIDGE SWITCHING TIME CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)



# TRANSIENT THERMAL IMPEDANCE CHARACTERISTICS (IGBT part)




## REVERSE RECOVERY CHARACTERISTICS OF FREE-WHEEL DIODE


